

Website Privacy Policy

1. Purpose of the Privacy Policy

The purpose of this Privacy Policy is to inform visitors to the France IX Services websites https://www.franceix.net/fr/ and https://marketplace.franceix.net (hereinafter the Site) about the use of their personal data.

2. What is the role of France IX Services?

In the context of the management of our website, we act as a data controller. As such, we decide why (purposes) and how (means) your data is used.

3. How is your personal data collected?

- We collect Personal Data that you provide to us directly through forms. This includes contact data such as surname/first name or email address, as well as any other information that you wish to bring to our attention (services which interest you, etc.) or data that you spontaneously communicate to us by contacting our teams or during our exchanges.
- Also, some of your data is collected automatically, through cookies. To find out more, see our cookie policy.

4. For what purpose and for how long do we use your personal data?

The table below summarises all the processing operations for which France IX Services may use your personal data.

5. Who is your personal data intended for?

Within France IX Services (internal recipients)

Your Personal Data is processed by authorized members of France IX Services' staff.

Outside France IX Services (external recipients)

Several categories of third parties listed below may have access to your Personal Data. Only the Personal Data that is strictly necessary is transmitted to them.

- Our service providers are involved in the delivery of the services (NOC, developers, etc.).
- Our marketing service providers (marketing agency, referencing management and solution for enriching and validating professional contacts) and cookie storage tools (Matomo: https://fr.matomo.org/privacy-policy/).
- Your data may be transmitted to our CRM (customer relationship management tool: Hubspot: https://legal.hubspot.com/fr/privacy-policy), to our email solution for the purpose of communicating with you (Gmail: https://policies.google.com/privacy?hl=fr-CA) and to our online file storage or sharing solution (Dropbox: https://www.dropbox.com/fr/privacy).

We ensure that these subcontractors contractually commit to implementing a level of protection equivalent to ours and in accordance with the Regulation.

France IX Services undertakes not to transmit your Personal Data to third parties unless:

- You have given your prior consent to the sharing of your Personal Data with third parties,
- Sharing your Personal Data with this third party is necessary for the provision of the requested services,
- A competent judicial or administrative authority requires that the Data be transmitted to it.



6. How your data is used by third-party platforms

Our website may contain links to other websites over which we have no control. We encourage you to read the privacy policies of the websites and apps you may interact with.

7. Transfer outside the EU

We endeavour to keep your Personal Data within the European Union. However, some of the services we use involve potential transfers. Concerned about the security and confidentiality of your Data, we inform you that when your Data is transferred outside the EU, we ensure that these transfers are made to:

- either from a country recognised by the European Commission as ensuring an adequate level of protection;
- or to a country that does not offer adequate protection but whose transfer is permitted, in particular by being governed by the European Commission's standard contractual clauses, which the CNIL has recognized as ensuring a sufficient level of protection of the privacy and fundamental rights of individuals.

8. What are your rights regarding your personal data?

a) Right of access

You can request and obtain information about the personal data we hold about you.

b) Right to rectification

You have the right to request the correction of your inaccurate or incomplete personal data.

c) Right to erasure

Also known as the "right to be forgotten", it allows you to request the deletion of your personal data unless the data must be retained:

- for compliance with a legal obligation,
- for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims.

d) Right to restriction of processing

This right allows you to request to limit the use of your personal data in certain circumstances:

- You have requested the rectification of your data, the processing may then be limited to the time it takes to verify the accuracy of your personal data;
- The processing is unlawful and you object to the erasure of your data and request the restriction of their use instead;
- The data controller no longer needs your data for the purposes of the processing, but it is necessary for you for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claim;
- You have objected to the processing and we will check whether our legitimate grounds prevail over yours.



e) Right to data portability

You may receive your personal data in a structured, machine-readable format, in order to transfer it to another organization.

f) Right to object

You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data on legitimate grounds, unless there are compelling legitimate grounds to continue processing.

Several processing of your personal data are subject to your consent. You can remove it at any time.

g) Right to make a complaint to the CNIL

You also have the right to submit a complaint to the CNIL, the supervisory authority (www.cnil.fr).

9. How to exercise your rights?

a) Procedures for exercising rights

You can submit your requests in the following ways:

b) Response time

France IX Services has a period of one month to respond to you from the receipt of your request. This period may be extended by two months due to the complexity of your request and the number of requests made to us; in this case you will be informed.
